

LEARNING PATHWAYS



NUIX 101

One-day training course designed to introduce students to the basics of the Nuix Workstation. Students will learn how to create a case; process different data types; and view, search, filter, tag, and export data. The class includes lecture phases and hands-on labs for students to apply what they’ve learned.
