NUIX INVESTIGATIONS & RESPONSE - FOUNDATIONS · THREE DAY INSTRUCTOR LED COURSE

The Nuix Investigations & Response - Foundations course is intended to take an examiner new to Nuix Workstation through techniques in creating cases, processing file data and analyzing evidence. Students will learn procedures to successfully create an investigations case and review the many pre-processing options for ingesting different formats of unstructured data and forensic images. Participants of this course will identify the various investigative features available within the tool to view, search, filter, tag, visualize and export data for reporting. This course is broken out into two sections, Core and Advanced Forensic Techniques. The Core modules are intended for investigators to identify core concepts and functionality of Nuix Workstation. The Advanced Forensic Techniques modules will highlight the key forensic features and functionality within Nuix Workstation, allowing for a swift and efficient investigation.

- **Prerequisites:** To obtain the maximum benefit from this course, participants should meet the following requirements: perform basic operations on a personal computer, be familiar with Microsoft Windows environments, at least 6 months.
- **Class Material:** Training manual with lab exercises.
